Week	Class Day	Designed Activities
1 st	1 st	Extension Lecture - Students interact with workers, supervisors, and engineers from small-scale industries. - Share experiences in the classroom.
2 nd	1 st	Extension Lecture - Continued from the previous week. - Discuss recent developments in engineering based on interactions
3 rd	1 st	Personality Development - Students answer at least 20 questionnaires from the MTBI personality type test. - Faculty may explain questions if needed. -
4 th	1 st	Personality Development - Review and discuss the results of the personality type test. - Explore the implications of personality types in professional development.
5 th	1 st	Environmental Issues - Students share experiences on major environmental issues (e.g., air pollution, water pollution, noise pollution). - Discuss forest and agricultural degradation. - Students propose remedial measures and perform an extempore skit.
6 th	1 st	Environmental Issues - Continued discussion and exploration of environmental issues. - Emphasis on brainstorming solutions and practical approaches.
7 th	1 st	Quiz - Organize a quiz competition covering non-technical topics such as politics, economics, sports, and current events. - Utilize audio-visual clips for answers.
8 th	1 st	Hobbies - Students share their hobbies and showcase related work. - Encourage students to develop new hobbies based on their interests.
9 th	1 st	Hobbies - Faculty assigns one activity related to their hobbies to each student for presentation. - Emphasize the importance of leisure and personal development.
10 th	1 st	Hobbies - Continued presentation of student activities related to their hobbies. - Provide constructive feedback.
11 th	1 st	Field Visit - Head of Department arranges a field visit near the campus. - Relate theoretical knowledge to real-world applications.
12 th	1 st	Quiz - Another quiz session covering diverse non-technical topics. - Enhance competitive spirit and general knowledge.
